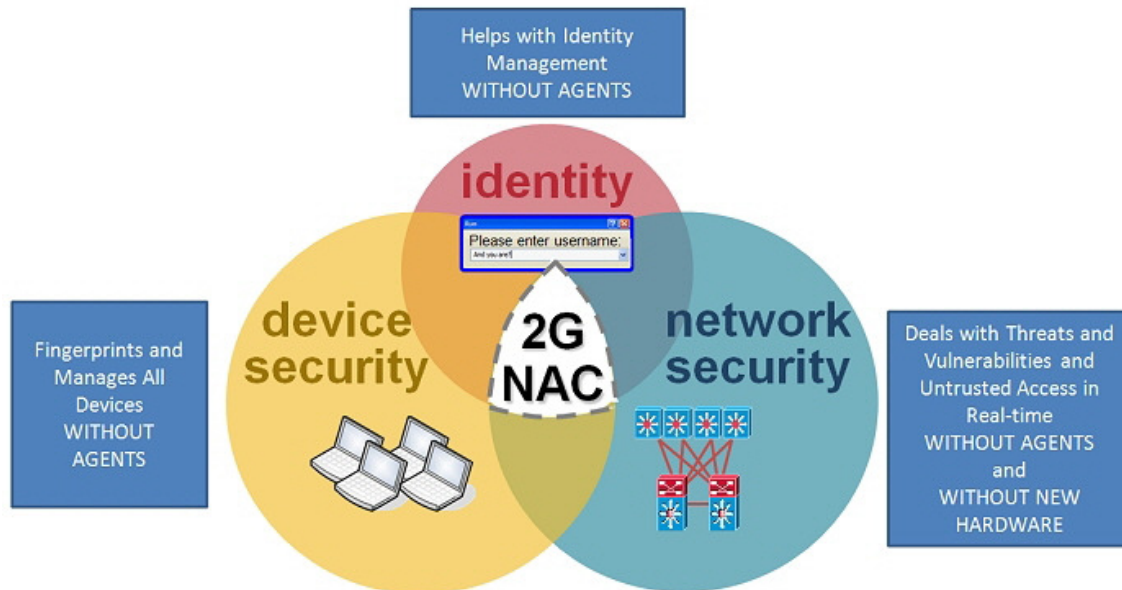


# Second Generation NAC – The 2G Difference
